Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACES)	Service User	Questions that assess stressful life events that occurred before the Service User was 18 years old.	2 minutes
Registration Demographics	Service User/Clinic Staff	Basic demographic information (e.g. Race, Ethnicity) collected for all Service Users that can be entered by clinic staff.	1 minute
Baseline Only Questions	Primary Support Person	Background and demographic information that should stay static and asked only once.	2 minutes
Pathway to Care	Clinician/Clinic Staff	Questions related to determination of duration of untreated psychosis (DUP) that happened prior to engagement with the EP program, including first date of treatment, first date taking antipsychotic medication, first date hospitalized.	5 minutes

Demographics & Background	Service User	Additional demographic information (e.g. housing, disability, religious status) collected for all Service Users.	5 minutes

Education	Service User	Questions ask about Service Users' educational background. If they are currently attending school, there will be a few additional questions about their current experience in school.	1 minute
Employment and Related Activities	Service User	Questions ask Service Users about employment and other related activities, such as volunteering.	2 minutes
Social Relationships	Service User	Questions ask about Service Users' relationships with family and friends.	1 minute
SCORE-15	Service User	Questions ask about Service Users' view of their family at the moment. "Family" can mean the people living in their house, but they can choose who they see as family.	3 minutes
Legal Involvement and Related	Service User	Questions ask about experiences Service Users' may have had with the police or legal system.	1 minute
Substance Use	Service User	Questions ask about experiences Service Users' may have had with substance use over the past 30 days.	1 minute
Medications	Service User	Questions about Service Users' thoughts about taking medication and experiences with medication(s), including side effects.	4 minutes
Intent to Attend and Complete Treatment Scale	Service User	Questions to understand the Service Users' plans for both attending and completing the EPI program.	1 minute
Modified Colorado Symptom Index	Service User	Questions ask Service Users about how often they experienced certain symptoms during the past month.	3 minutes
Questionnaire about the Process of Recovery (QPR)	Service User	Questions ask about what parts of recovery are important to the Service User, and to help understand where Service Users are at with their wellbeing.	3 minutes

Life Outlook	Service User	Questions ask Service Users about their current feelings about their goals and satisfaction with certain aspects of their life.	2 minutes
Hospitalizations	Service User	Questions ask Service Users about their hospitalization and emergency room experiences over the past 6 months.	2 minutes
Shared Decision Making and Treatment Satisfaction	Service User	Questions ask Service Users about their satisfaction with treatment and services provided in their clinic.	1 minute
Demographics & Background	Primary Support Person	Additional demographic information we collect for all Primary Support Persons.	3 minutes
Legal Interactions & Related	Primary Support Person	Questions ask about experiences Service Users' may have had with the police or legal system.	1 minute
SCORE-15	Primary Support Person	Questions ask about support persons' view of their family at the moment.	3 minutes
Burden Assessment Scale	Primary Support Person	Questions that ask support persons about how their loved one's experiences may impact them.	3 minutes
Modified Colorado Symptom Index	Primary Support Person	Questions ask support persons about how often Service Users experienced certain symptoms during the past month.	3 minutes
Medications	Primary Support Person	Questions ask support persons about Service Users experiences with medication(s), including side effects.	4 minutes
Diagnosis and DUP	Clinician/Clinic Staff	Questions ask providers about current diagnoses and service use history.	5 minutes
Family Involvement	Clinician/Clinic Staff	Questions ask providers about Service User contact frequency with family, family involvement in care, and factors that may impact family involvement.	3 minutes

Risk to Self/Others	Clinician/Clinic Staff	Questions about Service Users' risk to self or others.	3 minutes
Health	Clinician/Clinic Staff	Questions about health information (vitals) and lab results.	3 minutes
Medications	Clinician/Clinic Staff	Questions to assess Service User use of oral antipsychotics, long-acting injectables, and other psychotropic medications.	5 minutes
Service Use	Clinician/Clinic Staff	Questions about individual's service utilization over the past six months including service type, modality of delivery, and whether services were provided through agency or received through an outside agency.	3 minutes
Functioning*	Clinician/Clinic Staff	Report of clinical scales which assess social and role functioning. Also includes questions about number of close and casual friends and for the Service Users' primary role.	5 minutes
Symptoms*	Clinician/Clinic Staff	Report of clinical scales which assess symptoms.	3 minutes

Discharge and Planning	Clinician/Clinic Staff	Questions that assess the reason for discharge and what referrals were made to internal and external agencies.	3 minutes

It requires review of clinical records, administrative data, and staff interviews. All FEPS-FS assessments will be conducted in a remote format.
